Prayer:

Begin your time with prayer. Use the Hail, Holy Queen to prepare for praying the Rosary.

Make the Sign of the Cross. Hail, holy Queen, Mother of mercy, hail, our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To you we cry, the children of Eve; to you we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this land of exile. Turn, then, most gracious advocate, your eyes of mercy toward us; lead us home at last and show us the blessed fruit of your womb, Jesus: O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary. Make the Sign of the Cross.
