Lesson:The Beatitudes

- Share with your child that during Lent many focus their attention on helping others. Jesus teaches us about helping others through the scripture passage, The Sermon on the Mount. Watch this [video](#).
- Next, look up this scripture passage in the Bible- Matthew 5-7. Share with your child that just like in the book of Exodus when God gives Moses and Israelites the Ten Commandments to live by, Jesus gives us the Beatitudes to live a Christian life.

Attend Mass together as a family this weekend. If possible, take time after 10:30 Mass to attend the Stations of the Cross to continue on strengthening your prayer this Lenten season.
